

Communion Reflection... A peacock's feathers are very colourful; they are worn more for show than for warmth. The Pharisees wore their virtue for show; they wanted to be seen and praised by others. We may deceive others but we cannot deceive God. But then it would be foolish even to try. We don't have to put on an outward show, or pretend to be what we are not. All we have to do is try to be true to what we are – God's sons and daughters. Lord, help us to shun all falsity and pretense, and to live a life of genuine goodness. Then our deeds will flow from what we are, as naturally as good fruit from a good tree.

Will we continue to remember our war heroes? I hope so. Some say "let the dead bury their dead," however, and with many veterans passing on, the future of Remembrance Day can Postor seem as bleak as a November sky. The lapel pins we wear on Remembrance Day actually

started as a fund-raiser for Belgian children orphaned by the Great War. Will our own children care in the future? They should. It is important to use this day as an opportunity to encourage people to think about where we've gotten using war as a solution to our problems, to think about the lives lost and to think about new ways we can make the world a better place. There are so few people left alive who know what a global war is like. Soon, there won't be any. We wear the poppy in remembrance. If the poppy, a symbol of death and loss, doesn't also serve as a potent symbol of the need for peace, what could? You can tell people what happened long ago, and that's history – nothing can change it, but it is not something that should be forgotten, nor should the men and women who gave so much for the freedom we now enjoy.

O gentle Heart of Jesus, ever present in the Blessed Sacrament, ever consumed with burning love for the poor captive souls in Purgatory, have mercy on them.
