Communion Reflection... Up and down the land, Jesus walked and talked with women and men, boys and girls. He told stories, he shared meals, he taught, he healed, he laughed. And with every step, every word, Jesus loved and shared. During Lent, we're walking with Jesus. He's leading us, with our whole hearts, closer and closer to the Father. We will be praying more. We will be practising the habit of making small sacrifices. And we'll also, like Jesus, be giving of ourselves. We can do this in small ways, without anyone knowing. We can wash dishes without being asked. We can prepare a surprise snack. We can give more to those in need. We can do these things by ourselves, and we can give more as a family too. With our whole hearts, every day, we can let Jesus' love shine through us.



"Kingdom" is an old-fashioned word to folks who live in a democracy. It evokes castles, drawbridges, and royalty in crowns. It's a term best reserved for fairy tales. In modern slang, something or someone "rules" when they're of the highest quality. As in dark

chocolate-coated pretzels rule the snack bar! (In my opinion.) The central teaching of Jesus, interestingly, is not to promote himself as ruler of a kingdom. It's about that kingdom itself, better understood as the realm of God. It's where God rules, and not just in quality. The kingdom is the hour in which God's will is done on earth as it is in heaven. It's the fulfilment of the Lord's prayer. So when does God actually rule? Right now: wherever the divine will is being accomplished. The kingdom is near because it's a simple decision away. All you and I have to do to inhabit that realm is to turn and embrace gospel values: justice, peace, mercy, and hope. Let's meet in the kingdom soon!


"Lenting" isn't a word in the dictionary. Yet actively engaging in our spiritual growth offers a fresh approach to these 40 days before Easter. Years ago, perhaps you "gave up" candy during Lent. Years later, you're more spiritually mature. Perhaps this year you're turning off the phone each evening to free up additional devotional time. When we quiet our minds and mentally leave the demands of daily living to focus on our walk with Jesus, we can become more alert to input from the Holy Spirit. Early church fathers would applaud this active engagement in "Lenting." After all, they built this season into the Church to support a lifelong journey with Jesus. "Lenting" allows us to spiritually reframe in preparation for a vibrant Celebration of Christ's resurrection.



What Should I do for Lent?

Keep it Simple... Prayer is a recognition that we need help to turn back to God. From daily Mass, to the Rosary, to Centering Prayer, to the Stations of the Cross, to Eucharistic Adoration, the Church

encourages a wealth of prayerful practices. A very simple way to pray is to sit quietly for a moment before taking up one of the Gospels and slowly reading a passage that you like. Simply sit with the passage for a bit, savouring the Word and allowing it to touch you, read it again slowly, and then respond to God.



Today's Quote: Oh Lord, make this Lenten season different from the other ones. Let me find you again.

Provide-A-Meal... The last weekend of the month is our Chili Collection for The Good Shepherd. Pans and recipes are available on the porch of the house at St. John's Church. Over 1300 meals and snacks are served every day. Your generosity is giving suffering people the gift of presence – a place where their voices can be heard, where their human dignity is acknowledged.



At the end of the day, there's no truer adage than "can't live with 'em, can't live without 'em." Just as our bodies need food and air, our souls need connections with SUNDAY other people. We are at our best when we are in healthy relationships and at our worst

when we're not. Without connections, we just are not fully human. After thirty minutes of listening to a husband and wife talk about their marriage, the therapist got up and gave the wife a big hug. "Your wife needs this every day," she said. The husband replied, "okay, but I can only bring her here on Mondays and Thursdays." I know people who live with regrets after taking another person for granted and missing the opportunities to express and demonstrate affection. Saying "I love you" and following the words with hugs and kissed strengthens a relationship. Otherwise, it will die a slow death. Lost moments are lost moments, and there's no going back. During Lent, ask yourself: "Have I been taking someone for granted?" Do something about it-a visit, a phone call, a text, a hug, a kiss...connect with them through words and actions.


