

Communion Reflection... Our human love is corrupted by our sinfulness. We cannot escape the "What's in it for me?" syndrome. Jesus followed a much different path—not of self-interest, but of concern for us and all others. He was willing, even eager, to sacrifice himself for the benefit of all the sinners of the whole human race. On the cross he laid down his life for sinners he called his friends. He paid the ultimate price so that our sins could be forgiven ... our death defeated ... our future secured in glory. This is divine love at work in us each and every day-changing our corrupted hearts with his greater love. Open your heart again today to the greater love of Jesus. Share it will all the people in your corner of life. What can you offer up on behalf of another person today? Print "Whatever, Lord" on index cards. Embellish them with stickers and include this prayer on the back, "Jesus, I'm accepting your invitation to come to you, because I need you." Use as needed.



St. Ignatius of Loyola taught his early Jesuit brothers the importance of "discerning spirits," of learning to choose between the spirits that move us always toward God, and

the bad spirits that push us away from God. The trick, Ignatius taught, is knowing we are constantly choosing between the two. Now is a time to choose, to come clean with God, to repent and to ask for those renewed and right spirits. It is a time to awaken ourselves to this interior and ongoing battle of spirits. Most importantly, it is a time to remember that, even when we fail or fall, we always have the chance to begin again. Which spirits in your life have the upper hand? What do you need to begin again? Let's pray: Ever-creating God, continue your work in me. Re-create me daily in your love and renew what needs new life and a right spirit.

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart. Of all devotions, devotion to the Sacred Heart was, and remains, one of the most widespread and popular in the Church.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart is a wonderful historical expression of the Church's piety for Christ, her Spouse and

Lord: it calls for a fundamental attitude of conversion and reparation, of love and gratitude, apostolic commitment and dedication to Christ and his saving work. Devotions to the Sacred Heart of Jesus are numerous. Some have been explicitly approved and frequently recommended by the Apostolic See. Among these, mention should be made of the following: Personal consecration, described by Pius XI as "undoubtedly the principal devotional practice used in relation to the Sacred Heart." Family consecration to the Sacred Heart, in which the family, by virtue of the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony already participating in the mystery of the unity and love of Christ for the Church, is dedicated to Christ so that he might reign in the hearts of all its members. The Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, approved for the whole Church in 1891, which is evidently biblical in character and to which many indulgences have been attached.


