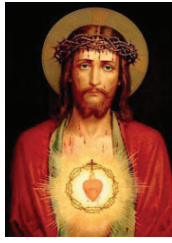
Today is ShareLife Sunday. Please give generously.

Communion Reflection... Some of us have two left feet. Whether we're dancing, climbing stairs or simply walking around the house, stumbling seems to be a daily occurrence. This is also true in regard to our faith walk with Jesus. It doesn't take much to get us off-balance. We often let trouble and opposition trip us up, and we fall into the temptation to react sinfully rather than rely on the steady hand of Jesus to uphold and guide us. Let us not forget that Jesus came for klutzy people like us. As he stumbled to the cross, bleeding and suffering, Jesus stood firm in his mission to take upon himself the punishment for our sins. Therefore, though we stumble, we fall into his grace where we find forgiveness and strength to follow him. Think about a specific time you may have stumbled and pray for his mercy to restore you. Jesus, forgive me when I stumble. Take my hand, that I may walk in your ways.



Wishing we had done more with our life is our great surrender and our freedom. Eternal life and God's mercy are never earned. Both are sheer gifts. What hope this gives us! We feed the hungry in our family; we are patient with our children; we are at the ready to help someone in need. We do little things with great love, not counting the cost. We know that we can always do more, but in surrendering to the present moment and its demands, we live this generosity all year long. We do the best we can and offer the undone to God's mercy. Read the newspaper and give the gift of prayer to those suffering in our global family. O God, anything I do is a mere drop in the bucket in the light of the world's suffering. There is always another person who needs help. Convince me that it is my effort that counts, not my success.

In the apparitions to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, Jesus gives these twelve promises for those who are devoted to His Sacred Heart.

4. They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of their death.
5. I will pour abundant blessings on all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source of an infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection.
9. I will bless the homes where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
10. I will give to priests the power of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced.
12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments; My heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.

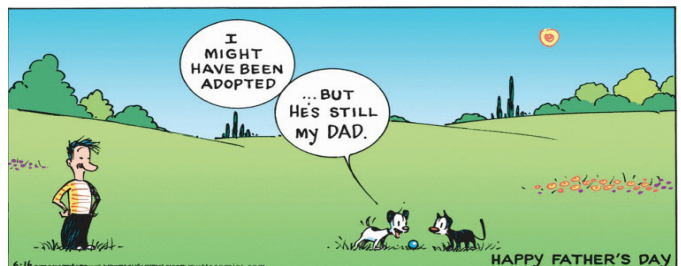
