

Blindsided. Caught of guard. Shocked.
Taken aback. Mary was blindsided by
Gabriel when she was told she was going to have a baby. "How can this be?" she asked. It hits us from nowhere—a health

issue, family problems, work conflict, emotional upheaval, financial disaster. We never saw it coming. "What am I going to do now?" we ask. What do you do when your partner suddenly proclaims: "It's over"? They back it up with "Something is missing" or "It's just not working." you're devastated, but you need to take a step back, try to make sense of what's happening, and believe you will get back on your feet. Distance yourself as you start to recover emotionally. Try a change of scenery. Healing can happen in a new environment, free of all the reminders of your partner. Don't bury your hurt-drain the pain and get it all out. Set a limit on how long you cry, scream, or get angry. Don't let it consume you. Then move on with your day. Eliminate all the negative chatter in your head and replace it with positive affirmations: "I'm worth more than this." "I have something to offer." Don't keep looking in the rearview mirror. Life is meant to be lived moving forward. When you're blindsided, follow this recipe: Take time to heal. Be tender with yourself. And talk to others.

Teacher Candidates... The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board requires all teacher applicants to submit a pastoral portfolio/reference when applying for a teaching position. It is the responsibility of the candidate to attend Sunday liturgy, be involved in parish life and



contact the parish priest well in advance. Teacher candidates who are attending school out of the local area are also responsible to give the pastor advance notice. The pastor cannot complete the form if he does not know the applicant. It is the responsibility of the candidate to download and complete their portion of the form before submitting to the church. 
