Communion Reflection... Once there was a rich man addicted to amassing ever greater amounts of wealth. He lived for himself and shared nothing with those who needed his help. One night he had a dream in which he saw the suffering his selfishness had caused. When he awoke, he saw the need to change. At first, letting go of his addiction was hard. But his loss was offset by the joy he began to feel in helping others and in being accepted as a loving member of his community. Are there obstacles in your life preventing you from living with greater love and joy? Would now be an appropriate time to think about this? Only with God's help can we more fully become the person God created us to be. Loving God, may I be able to recognize and let go of any thoughts and actions that prevent me from loving you and from giving caring service to others. May I always be open to your guidance.



Why should we be surprised if we are misjudged, badgered or persecuted? Jesus got many raw deals in his life and so will we as we are not greater than our Master. However, persecution

can be a disguised blessing, revealing our desire for power, control and calling us to practice the art of forgiveness, bringing us out of our personal isolation and onto our knees. Let's look at our lives and the harsh, undeserving words spoken to us. How did we handle them? Did we dig for the hidden treasures and thank God that we had an opportunity to imitate the One who redeems us and loves us beyond all telling? Recall a time when you lost hope and felt judged. Then dig for the hidden treasures. O God, grant me the grace never to hurt another by my words or actions. Each day, may they both be fair, true and gently loving.

I checked myself into a rehab center." when we feel like we're bound in chains, we have the ability to break free. First, we have to recognize that nothing is impossible to get past. People face all kinds of heartaches-bankruptcy, addictions, conflict with relatives, rejections and loss. We need to stop pretending we've got it all together and admit: "I'm hurting. I need help!" Reach out to those offering to walk with you through your troubles, knowing others have traveled this road before you. You need a safe place to let out your tears, angers, and disappointment without feeling ashamed. And you need a place to find hope again. When you see others who are happier and healthier, you can believe that you will be like them too, someday. You're not alone in your pain. Help is there for the asking. Find a support group with others experiencing the same issues. They'll help you navigate through the tough times.

Teacher Candidates... The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board requires all teacher applicants to submit a pastoral portfolio/reference when applying for a teaching position. It is the responsibility of the candidate to attend Sunday liturgy, be involved in parish life and



contact the parish priest well in advance. Teacher candidates who are attending school out of the local area are also responsible to give the pastor advance notice. The pastor cannot complete the form if he does not know the applicant. It is the responsibility of the candidate to download and complete their portion of the form before submitting to the church. 
