In fact, any decision should first be put into the hands of God in order for us to make that decision in the right spirit. It is God's companionship that transforms every situation.

Teacher Candidates... The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board requires all teacher applicants to submit a pastoral portfolio/reference when applying for a teaching position. **It is the responsibility of the candidate to attend Sunday liturgy, be involved in parish life and contact the parish priest well in advance.** Teacher candidates who are attending school out of the local area are also responsible to give the pastor advance notice. The pastor cannot complete the form if he does not know the applicant. It is the responsibility of the candidate to download and complete their portion of the form before submitting to the church.
