Communion Reflection... Whenever families gather, inevitably someone says, "Remember when...," marking the beginning of memory-sharing, which other family members then expand upon or edit based on their own recall. So it is with the family of Christ, as Christians recall the sacrificial love of Jesus. Sunday is a great time to remember – a time to recall and reflect on the narrative of our Saviour as we sit at Mass. Though not present, we know the story of our salvation as found in Scripture. Each generation retells the next about God's promise of a Saviour, the birth of Jesus, his life, death and resurrection, and his presence among us today. The narrative of Jesus is our narrative to share within and outside of our family of faith. The story of Jesus is our story to tell, live and celebrate.

Then pray, God of all, use me as I am and as you need me. Take all I have to offer. You have given all to me, and to you I return it.


