Communion Reflection... A great pianist who spoke eight languages was struck with case of hoarseness. He feared the worst-was it cancer? He went to a throat specialist. The doctor seemed quite serious and the pianist could not read his expression. The doctor told him to come back the next day. The pianist couldn't sleep a wink. He returned the next day for another long examination. The doctor said nothing. Finally, the pianist pleased with the doctor to give him the news—he could handle it. Finally the physician spoke: "You talk too much." I wonder if that is what God thinks about our prayer. We can babble on and on—mindless of what we are saying. We may believe that more is better. No. God wants us to pray from our heart. Speak as a child to its parent. Pray with confidence and trust. Keep it simple. Say what is on your mind and leave the rest in God's hands. He knows what we need. Trust him.



It's not always easy to bear with one another, especially when people become difficult or even unbearable. Whatever we have to put up with, however, is nothing compared to what Jesus endured while hanging powerless on the cross. In fact, the first words from Jesus' lips were words of forgiveness for those who had nailed him to that cross. Thankfully, Jesus forgives us for every desire for revenge or hurt we inflict, even when we know very well what we are doing, and so we are moved to be patient, kind and forgiving with others.
