Communion Reflection... It was a cry of total desperation, a feeling of complete abandonment. That is what Jesus experienced as he suffered the consequences of human sin on the cross. It's the cry also of many Christians who see no sign of relief from persistent affliction. Then it is time to recall what Jesus did for us on the cross, to free us from the curse of our sins. Psalm 22 is an expression of faith that God will not fail to come to our rescue in due time. Could it be that Jesus, with perfect faith, was praying the psalm's words of trust even as he suffered the worst? We can be sure that our loving God will never abandon us. Because of what Jesus did we are "cocooned in grace" as we await our final release into an eternity of life with our Saviour and our Heavenly Father.



I once saw a movie based on a true story. A coast guard crew goes out to sea one stormy night on a rescue mission. When all the town lights go out, the townspeople rush to the harbor and turn on their car lights so the guardsmen can find their way back to shore. We are called to do something similar—work together and rescue others who need to find their way back to Jesus. With grace, we can go out in the darkness of the world and rescue others. We can gather with others—pooling our lights of Christ's love into one bright beacon of hope. Jesus, help me join with others to spread your love.

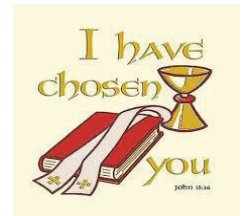

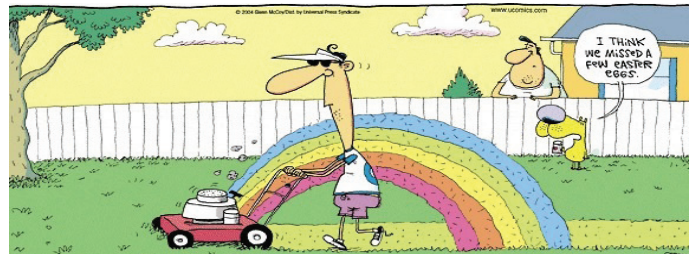
