### May the Month of Mary

One sign of the Christian spirit is that our thoughts turn to the spiritual side of each season of the year. The month of December brings thoughts of Christmas; March is linked in our thoughts with Lent and Easter; October is the month of the rosary. And the month of May brings us memories of Mary and reminds us of our devotion to her. The union of the month of May and Mary is quite natural. The very names are interchangeable. **Pastor's Easter Message**

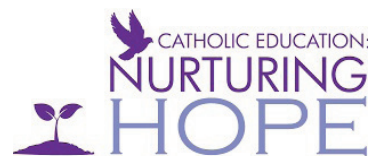
