Communion Reflection... Joseph of

Arimathaea, Christ's secret disciple, was assisted by Nicodemus in receiving Jesus' body from the cross. With tender care and courage, they welcomed the Divine One in his broken humanness, placing the sacred body in a new tomb. Here is a hint that death, the most certain thing of all, now meets something absolutely new. Nicodemus, the helper, carried beauty to the beloved body, lavishly bringing a wealth of scented oil and spices. Nicodemus knew the darkness of fear and the unknown. In this moment of ultimate anguish, he brought sweetness—a perfume, the hint of witness that death and decay are not the final word. Death has been changed forever. Because Christ entered into it, death has become the doorway to eternal life.

For many, "holiness" is a word we only think about in relationship to the saints, people who lived such extraordinary lives of faith that their witness, living, and charity have inspired generations. What we learn from saints is that holiness is not generic. Living as Christ's people is very particular—dependent upon the persons we are, the gifts we have been given, and the specific circumstances of our lives. 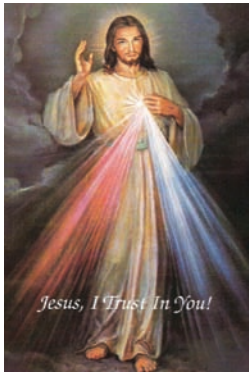

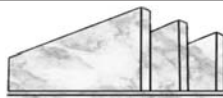
