While youngsters are able to expend a great deal of energy enjoying the physical world, we who do not have the same physical stamina should be more inclined to explore our spiritual lives. The inability to run around for hours on end like a child should not stop us from using what energy we have listening to what God could be trying to tell us. A child's wonder at the most ordinary items might teach us the value of not taking even the smallest things for granted. Children are always excitedly learning about the outside world. May we never stop wanting to learn about the world within us.
