Communion Reflection... Mary's response to the announcement of the angel that she was to be the mother of God shows us what the steward's response is to be: yes. A simple assent to the will of God, confounding, confusing, and uncertain as it might be. Mary's yes happened in a moment, and yet was no doubt the fruit of a lifetime of prayer, union with God, and growing in desire to fulfill whatever God called her to do with her life. Mary opened herself to the astounding news that God wanted her to do something special, something only she could do. Mary's yes inspires us to find the grace to also desire to grow close to God and fulfill whatever God calls us to do. You too are invited by God to do something special, something only you can do. While this is a significant and profound way to live, it is also a very joyful way of life. Mary's song of praise is testimony to this: "My soul rejoices in God my saviour!"



One thing which can disrupt our One thing which can disrupt our transformation into fully committed followers of Christ is the temptation to reject the way of the cross, which

seems like foolishness to the people of the world, and return to our old, self-centered way of life. Our spiritual transformation takes off when we, prompted by God's Spirit and encouraged by mature believers, resist Satan's temptation to bail out, and get on board with our Lord's way of suffering and sacrifice. As we take up our cross daily and follow Christ in faith, we are acknowledging our Lord as the true pilot of our life, rather than just the flight attendant or the co-pilot. It will still be a bumpy ride at times, as we travel through our life in this world. But as God's spirit helps us soar above the clouds of guilt and shame, we will experience in a new way the sunshine of Christ's love and grace and mercy. And no matter how much turbulence we encounter on our journey, we will safely reach our destination. Jesus, Saviour, pilot us through all of the turbulence of life, all the way from here to eternity.







