but when his wife was nudged into the water by a clumsy brother passing by, he may have begun to change his mind about what a monastery was. Superficial solemnity, thankfully, was never part of my experience. I have always favoured the kind of spiritual involvement that begets rather than kills earthly humour and even ribaldry. The perspective of divinity can be defined as all that is contrary to human intention and dignified expectation. We know we are moving more deeply into the spirit when we notice the presence in us of holy foolishness. And who is to say that this was not a case of baptismal renewal?
