

Communion Reflection... "Once" is a very

popular adverb with which to start a story. It helps to set the scene. It takes us back to when our story begins. Let's use it to begin our Advent journey this year. God created them by hand, and God made them perfectly. Once, Adam and Eve walked and talked with God. Once, God's world was a perfect paradise. The first Sunday in Advent is our wakeup call. The Lord, awakens us, not with shouts and clamour, but more often than not with a quiet whispering in our hearts.


