

Communion Reflection... The first Sunday in Advent is our wake-up call. The Lord, awakens us, not with shouts and clamour, but more often than not with a quiet whispering in our hearts. Perhaps we do not recognize it because the call is drowned out by the noise of Christmas commercialization: shopping trips, parties, decorating, and must-see specials on TV. We need to take time to be quiet and still; even a few minutes a day can help us as we prepare for Christmas. This Advent, heed the Lord's wake-up call and spend time with him.



Have you ever had to make a new start? Maybe you changed jobs or moved to a new city/country or welcomed someone new into your family. What was it like?

Was it exciting? Scary? The people of Israel had to make a new start. It wasn't easy. When Moses led them out of slavery, they didn't even know where to go, so God sent a pillar of fire to guide them. God guides us too. He gives us his commandments and the teachings of Jesus. He directs us through our parents and our church. God doesn't just lead us forward, though. He also reaches out to us, right where we are. That's what light does, after all. It spreads out in every direction at once. The pillar of fire lead the Israelites forward, but it also shone back across the desert to them. God travels across the darkness to be with us even as he lights our way home.

Please pray for peace and especially the people of Ukraine; join us in saying a Hail Mary every day.
