





Communion Reflection... Do you ever get tired of people telling you what to do? Do you ever argue or complain about that? All those chores and reminders can get old. So can giving out all those reminders! This week, see if there's something you can start doing without a reminder. Try to do it without arguing or complaining. It might feel a little strange at first. Complaining can be a bad habit-one that dims our light a little. If we ask, though, Jesus can help us break that habit and shine a little brighter in the world. Dear Jesus, help me to stop complaining and to be grateful for what I have.



Jesus sent his followers to live as he taught. PASTOR He sent them to tell the whole world about him. The disciples were only human though.

They made mistakes. They didn't always agree with each other. They weren't perfect, but Christ made them to carry his light into the world anyway. Christ calls us to share his light too. Living as children of light means doing what is good and right and true-for God, for others and for ourselves. Before we begin our Lenten season, let us reflect on some of the practical ways we can carry the light of Christ with us wherever we go, not just during these coming 40 days, but for the rest of the year as well.
