Communion Reflection... What baggage do I bring into each new day that I should get rid of before I get out of bed? So much is going on in our lives that we can lose sight of ourselves. Amid the scheduling, food preparation, gatherings with friends and family, work, and maybe even complaining about how busy everything is--what sins, what failings, what un-Christlike characteristics am I carrying around with me? Can I wait in confidence that the promises God had made will be fulfilled? If I rush through my days unreflectively, or worse, clinging tightly to my selfishness, what do I hope to gain in my life? Let us be people who wait on God's every word so we can be transformed and offer our new selves as gifts.



So many attitudes in our culture today run contrary to the wisdom of the Gospel. We seek to have control over every part of our lives, and sometimes even the lives of others. We profess a dizzying array of different identities rather than focusing on our shared humanity. We do everything we can to avoid suffering. We often choose to be alone rather than have to deal with other people who might make demands on us. But the Gospel asks us to magnify the Lord, to open ourselves in love toward others and work together to bear one another's burdens. This is the building up of the kingdom. This is the formation of a community of love.

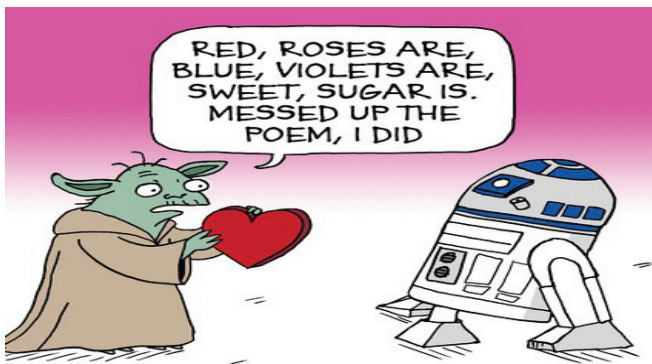
