Communion Reflection...

“What is this world coming to?” I don’t know how often I’ve said those very words. It seems that every day there’s something new in the news or in my personal life that causes me to lose sleep or pressures me to give up on humanity. All the more reason to take Jesus seriously when he says, “Be alert at all times.” He’s not so much warning us to watch out for the bad in the world around us, but rather, he’s reminding us what really matters. Namely, that the real life-giving question is not “What is this world coming to?” but “Who came into this world for us?” That’s what I believe makes for a life that is filled with the possibility of living confidently, trusting that in all things, God will guide our every step in every day.



I think I will forever struggle with the conundrum: I am a sinner, but God, Almighty God, loves me anyway. Yet while I struggle, God goes all out to prove his love by letting his Son Jesus lay out the truth of his love in dying. It’s as if God is saying, “Yes, yes, I know you’re a sinner; you’ve told me that a thousand times. But when are you going to hear me when I say it’s not all about you—it’s about Jesus. Jesus came to prove my love, and he did it with a cross.” I suspect that I will always in some way wrestle with the idea that God could really love me, as the hymn says, “Jesus as I am without one plea.” But in my head and heart, I still keep hearing Jesus saying, “I love you, I forgive you, and that’s that.”

During this season of Lent, help us take good care of your creation, the gift you have freely given.

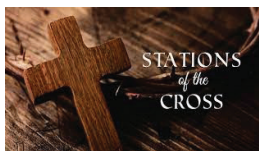
May we cultivate and protect it for future generations.

Keep it Simple... Prayer is a recognition that we need help to turn back to God. From daily Mass, to the Rosary, to Centering Prayer, to the Stations of the Cross, to Eucharistic Adoration, the Church encourages a wealth of prayerful practices. A very simple way to pray is to sit quietly for a moment before taking up one of the Gospels and slowly reading a passage that you like. Simply sit with the passage for a bit, savouring the Word and allowing it to touch you, read it again slowly, and then respond to God.

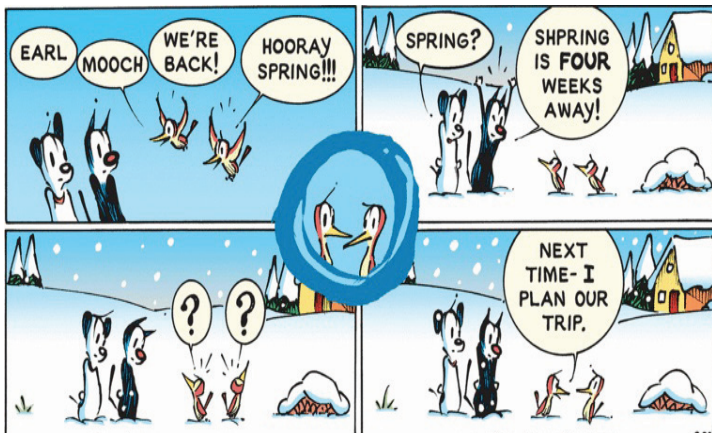
