

Communion Reflection... An elderly couple in their 80s lived on a farm that had seen better days; the barn was falling down, the rusted machinery was falling apart. One day while visiting, their son took a picture of his weather worn parents, with the barn and rusted machinery in the background. The parents decided to display the photo in the entrance of their home. Below the picture, it said "God is with us in our mess." Often we feel in the midst of a mess: health challenges, disagreements, and a chaotic world. God does not only come to us when we and all our circumstances are perfect. God does not take a vacation from us when our lives or the world seem to be falling apart. God is there to comfort and to strengthen us to handle those moments. The message is not that we are insulated from life's messiness, but rather, in the mess, God is always with us, giving us strength, understanding, and wisdom to live in the messed-up world inside us and around us.



As a man strolled the beach, he noticed an earnest fellow picking up starfish that had been washed ashore during low tide and throwing them back into the ocean. The man said, "But there must be a

thousand starfish here. You can't possibly get all of them. And this is probably happening on hundreds of beaches along the coast. You can't possibly make a difference." The local man picked up another starfish, and as he threw it back into the sea, he replied, "Made a difference to that one!" As you let go of feelings of hopelessness because today's challenges might seem impossible, focus on the people near you. What seemingly insignificant thing could you do to make a difference for one person today?

Q: Why do we get ashes on our foreheads on Ash Wednesday? A: The ancient Jews, wearing sackcloth and covering themselves or sitting in ashes, showed repentance and humility. The early Church adopted the practice of wearing ashes at the start of Lent to show repentance too. As the priest places the ashes on our foreheads, he says, "Remember you are dust and unto dust you will return" to remind us that our time on earth will pass away, but our life in Heaven will last forever.

Fasting and Abstinence are practices of self-denial that help a person to focus on the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of others. They also clear the mind and body for deeper contemplation in prayer.

Days of fasting: Ash Wednesday, March 2 Good Friday, April 15

Fasting requirements: One full or two light meatless meals; no eating between meals, but liquids are permitted.

Age of fasting: All persons between 18 and 59. Days of abstinence: Ash Wednesday and All Fridays during Lent

Abstinence requirements: No Meat.

Age of abstinence: All persons over the age of 14. No Catholic should fail to keep these days of required penance unless he or she has a serious reason for not observing them. The obligation on any individual day is not a question of serious sin. You may ask what penances we would suggest? The best idea during Lent is daily participation in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Try to be more patient with members of your own family and with persons working with you. Yes, abstaining from alcoholic beverages, smoking, candy, movies and TV programs gives so many opportunities for other penances. Above all, don't forget to say every morning as you open your eyes: "All for you, my Jesus, all for you!" Renew this intention often during the day. Try these few suggestions and we promise you that you will be a very different person at the end of the 40 day period which we call LENT.
