Today's Quote: Start by doing what's necessary, then what's possible, and suddenly you are doing the impossible.

Communion Reflection... There are some people we know so well, we can tell they are near without even hearing their name. You answer the phone and just by the voice you hear, you know it's your good friend or your grandmother. How do you know? Because of all the time you've spent together. You're in your room and you hear footsteps in the hall. Who's coming? A light, quick step? A heavy tread? You can probably tell who it is by the familiar step you've heard before. When we know someone, we recognize their voice. We sense their presence just from the signs we know so well. It's the same with the Lord. We want to become so close to him that we recognize his voice, speaking to us in love. How can this happen? By being with him, talking to him and, in the quiet, listening, every day.



"I've got your back," they say. "You can count on me!" But then, just when you need them, they're a no-show. Promises are broken. Trust is gone. The pain of betrayal runs deep. Loved ones are disloyal. Friends are dishonest. We often find ourselves disconnecting emotionally from people as we hide behind walls we construct of mistrust. We stay in hiding, protecting our vulnerability. We close people out, allowing fear and anger to prevent us from reconnecting to people who genuinely do care about us. The bottom line: not everyone is out to hurt us. If you've been betrayed, give yourself a time-out to make sense of what happened. Then, when you're ready, talk it out with the person who hurt you. Share how you feel and ask, "Why did you do this to me?" Then tell them what you need from them in order to move on. The choice to tear down walls, rebuild, and repair trust is yours. Your relationship just might come out stronger and better as it grows deeper.
