Communion Reflection... People are amazed when they recall how much time has passed since they began a certain phase in their life. Their years of marriage, living in the same house, working at the same job or sustaining a friendship seem to go unnoticed until they stop to think about it. God never marks the time of our spiritual progress. He doesn't count the years it took to develop our faith to the depth it is today or the gradual way we've become kinder over the years. God just rejoices in where we are and doesn't consider how long it took us to get there. All this might give us something to think about when we find ourselves getting impatient with people.



Pray daily for Faith. It is your only requisite for the accomplishment of mighty deeds. Certainly you have to work, you have to pray, but upon




