### Communion Reflection...

Thousands of years ago, some ancient people thought that the sun was a god. As Christians, we know that God isn't the sun. God made the sun. God made every living thing—people, plants, and animals. In some way, though, God is like the sun. Sometimes, the sun shines brightly, bathing us in warmth and light. We often feel God's presence as strongly as that. When we are counting our blessing, for instance, we may feel very close to God. Other times, the sun hides behind a cloud, and it disappears from us every night, leaving us in darkness. Sometimes it might seem like God does that too. When we are lonely or hurting, for example, God might feel very far away from us. The truth is, God is always with us—when we're happy and when we are hurting, when we're sinful and when we are sorry. Even when we're not aware of God, he is watching over us, just like the sun is always shining, even when we cannot see it.

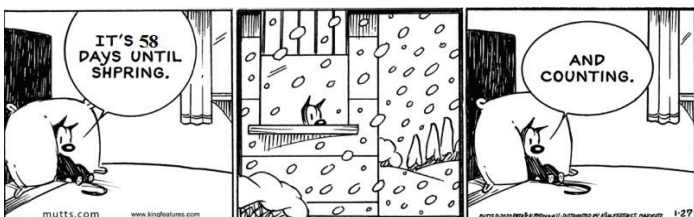
