Communion Reflection... When you have a tough decision to make, it helps to do something else for a while to give your mind a break. Poor St. Joseph couldn't binge watch his favourite shows or organize his sock drawer, but he did something much wiser and more beneficial. He went to sleep. As parents, you want your kids to get enough rest, but you often sacrifice your own. Sure, there are times when you have no choice, but sometimes the rest you need is more than physical sleep. You might need a rest from food or information overload. You might need a rest from thinking our yourself too much, or even thinking about others too much. What do you need rest from? It can be hard to recognize, so pray for God's help to find your real need here. Make a conscious effort to get more rest, starting today.



A challenging story tells of a man who meets an angel walking down the road. In one hand the angel is carrying a bucket of water, in the other a flaming torch. When the man asks the angel what she is doing, she replies, "With this water I'm going to quench the fires of hell; with the torch I'm going to burn the mansions of heaven. Then, perhaps, we'll find out who really loves God." Hopefully, we are all searching for a relationship rather than being motivated by reward or fear of punishment. The comfort and the challenge of the Incarnation, the mystery we celebrated during Advent, is that God first loved us so absolutely that Jesus came to reveal more of the wonder of God, inviting us to fall deeper and deeper in love with God. Following some of your various actions today, take short moments to ask yourself: why am I doing this—to be rewarded, because of fear, or because my loving relationship with God animates my decisions and activities?

FROM THE PASTOR



"Glory" is a passionate word. Only the passionate experience glory. Jesus came to glory through his passionate act of offering himself for us on the cross. We, too, surrender to the crosses we bear, not just with resignation, but with passion (a passion of will, because emotions aren't free). Christians don't just accept the cross; we embrace it. And our "crosses" are any results of the sin of the world—from inconveniences to serious grief—that fall on our shoulders. We bear them with all the love we can to redeem the world. But it is Christ's passion that brings us to glory, not ours. When Paul says, "in my flesh I am completing what is lacking in Christ's afflictions." (Colossians 1:24), all that is lacking is Christ visibly suffering in our time. That he does in us, his body. We simply unite ourselves to him to express his love visibly in our flesh today. If we try to be passionate about letting Jesus express himself in our bodies, we will keep bearing our crosses with more understanding, more love, and a greater sense of glory.
