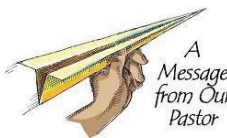

Communion Reflection... There was a preacher, one day he was passing a large church when he spotted people selling their trinkets, food items, and religious articles. There was incense, candles, veils and rosaries for sale. What caught his eye was several small boys selling crosses. In a loud enthusiastic voice they shouted, "Crosses, cheap crosses for sale! Get your cheap cross today!" Crosses are not cheap. Jesus' cross certainly wasn't and ours are not either. The cross is the challenge in following Jesus. We have to say no to our selfish desires. Though often in this world we do not follow God's values. That can be a challenge. In our pain, we don't curse our struggles but offer them up in union with Jesus, for the cross leads to life. Not only in the next life, but right here. We live in union with Christ. It is worth the sacrifice.



I remember standing at the gravesite of a homeless man I had never met. The local funeral director called saying, "This man has no family, but would you mind coming and saying a few words?" When I arrived at the scene, the only people present were the funeral director, two attendants and those who dug the grave. When I looked at the casket, I thought about how this man was once a child of parents who gave life to him, named him and believed in him. I also thought that now, though his life was over, there was another person near the grave that day. It was Jesus, who knew this man's name and love him the way he loved me.
