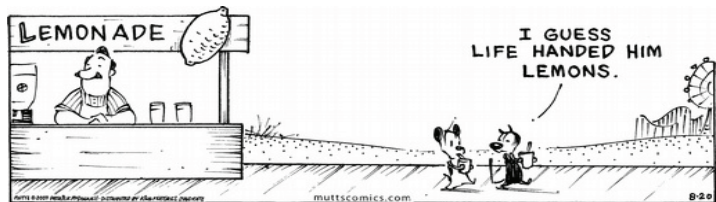


Young and Restless Social ~ Spiritual ~ Service

FROM THE PASTOR Do you know what it is to be hungry? Most of us in our comfortable society would probably say, "No." So many of us live a very good life. Of course, there are thousands who go to food pantries every week to get provisions to live on for the week. The pantries are able to offer the basics, non-perishable items, milk and occasionally some meat. Children will come along with their mothers and grandmothers. In this world of ours, there is still so much hunger, here and throughout the world, which is to say nothing at all about so many malnourished souls. In this gospel story a large crowd is following Jesus because he has been healing the sick. What unfolds is a stunning story, of course. Think of it: Jesus providing lunch to thousands. Can you imagine the surprise of the little boy whose five loaves and two fish are distributed to so many? How different it might have been if the boy refused to share. Jesus' own ministry was facilitated here by the cooperation of a child. This is, of course, a call to us all to reach out to the needs of others. Whatever we contribute, Christ will make it grow. This is so much more than a story about lunch. Exactly what happened and how, we do not know, but we do know that the story witnesses to the bounteous care of God for his people.
