The Body of Christ. The gift of His real presence teaches a paradox about the two realms of being. In the physical world the lower form of life becomes the higher when it is consumed. Elements are consumed by plants; plants are consumed by animals, animals are consumed by humans. Therefore, the lesser becomes the greater. In the spiritual realm the greater

being, Jesus, lowers Himself to be consumed by the lesser being, we disciples, in order that we can be raised up. We celebrate a "tripod" of Jesus' comprehensive presence. First, we have the gift of His real presence in the **Eucharist**. Second, He is present to us via **people** in the church and in the Holy Orders of deacon, priest, and bishop. Third, He is present to us in His **Word**. For this reason we stand at the Gospel just as we would if an honored guest entered our home. All three "legs of this tripod" are important if His presence is to truly work in the world. Take one away – each "leg" will continue to be real, but the "tripod" may fall over and be unable to carry the weight it was meant to hold.
