

Pope Francis @Pontifex... The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is an immense mystery, which exceeds the capacities of our minds, but that speaks to our heart, because we find it encompassed in that expression of Saint John which summarizes all of Revelation: "God is love".

On the Lighter Side: The gift of fear of the Lord: Do not ride in automobiles: they are responsible for 20% of fatal accidents. Do not stay home: 1% of all accidents occur in home. Do not walk on the streets or sidewalks: 14% of all accidents occur at such times. Do not travel by air, rail, or water: 16% of all accidents happen on planes, trains or boats. Only .001% of all deaths occur in worship services in Church, and these are usually related to previous physical disorders. Hence, the safest place for you to be at any time is at Church!!!



Communion Reflection... Everyone loves compliments, appreciation and a "thank you" note. We even feel compelled to check and recheck the number of "likes" our posts get on Facebook! What are we seeking? Do we only become who we are in the eyes of others? St. Paul urges the Galatians, and us, to be true to the gospel, to be slaves of Christ. He advises us not to be swayed by our egos that constantly shout, "Look at me! I am cool! I am in the 'in group'." Or, "I've got it right!" The ego is rarely satiated for long. It demands more and more approval. Remember, our false selves need to be constantly propped up by "like"; our true selves rest in Christ. Take notice of when you are trying to seek approval from others and pray, Oh, Lord, help me to go deeper than superficial popularity; help me to go straight to you.



Once a year, we have the St. Vincent de Paul bin in our parking lot. What a relief to be able to donate what we no longer need or what no longer fits in our lives, to remove some of the clutter from our home. It's also a relief to rid ourselves of spiritual clutter, and now is just the time to do it. So what should we leave behind as we move forward, reflecting on Christ's great love for us? Excuses for our sins are tripping hazards as they make it easier to sin again. Let's get rid of our excuses! Our faith can collapse with a rusty (lazy) prayer life—our being indifferent to God's presence, goodness and power. Goodbye laziness! Let's free our souls of clutter and celebrate Christ's resurrection, singing, "Oh happy day!" While praying about your spiritual clutter, get rid of the clutter in your home. The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart. Of all devotions, devotion to the Sacred Heart was, and remains, one of the most widespread and popular in the Church.



The feast of the Sacred Heart was approved for specified dioceses by Pope Clement XIII in 1765, and extended to the whole Church by Pope Pius IX in 1856. In 1889 Pope Leo XIII elevated it to the rank of first class, and through an encyclical letter in 1899 dedicated the whole Catholic world to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Devotion to the Sacred Heart was also an essential component of Pope John Paul II's hopes for the "new evangelization" called for by the Church. "For evangelization today," he said, "the Heart of Christ must be recognized as the heart of the Church: It is He who calls us to conversion, to reconciliation. It is He who leads pure hearts and those hungering for justice along the way of the Beatitudes. It is He who achieves the warm communion of the members of the one Body. It is He who enables us to adhere to the Good News and to accept the promise of eternal life. It is He who sends us out on mission. The heart-to-heart with Jesus broadens the human heart on a global scale."
