

**Communion Reflection...** The Gospel shows clearly that Peter was a man of action; he always needed to be doing something. So on Mount Tabor, instead of contemplating in silence and wonder the glory of his Lord, he wanted to build three tents. There is a time for stillness, for contemplation, for wonder, for adoration in the presence of God. A time to heed the words of the psalmist: 'Be still, and know that I am God.' Sometimes we are too busy. We would be better to be silent, to be listening, to be wondering, to be adoring in the presence of God.



When we look back on our life and realize the many fears and insecurities we had when we were younger, it might surprise us to see what we've accomplished despite it all. We had so little to work with yet we achieved so much.

God, of course, knew it would all work out even though we worried whether or not we had what it took to succeed at what we wanted. There are times in life when we question our faith. Doubts may occur concerning our faith in God or even faith in ourselves. When this happens, it might help to recall the great things we've accomplished with what we thought was so little. God believed in us and helped us believe in ourselves so we could succeed. He hasn't stopped believing and you shouldn't either.
