## Communion Reflection... Mark twain, the great

American author, wit, and satirist, was travelling through Europe with his daughter. No matter what city they visited, royalty, government leaders, and famous artists honoured Mark Twain. This display of fame astounded his daughter. At the end of their excursion, she asked, "Dad, you know everybody but God, don't you?" What a shame it would be if we came to the end of our life and the one person we had failed to meet was Jesus. Do we know the Lord? Not simply to know the facts about his life, but to know him as a close, personal friend. To know someone, we need to spend time with that person, opening up and sharing our inner self. In the spiritual life, we call this communication "prayer." Let us prepare for Easter by spending time in prayer. Get to know the Lord.



Often we try to cover up our mistakes, failures, and imperfections. We are bombarded by advertisements that entice us to improve our weight, looks, finances. We seek perfection in all the wrong places. Sooner or later we must accept the reality of the human situation: we

are far from perfect. To grow in the spiritual life is not to admire our successes, but to humbly admit our errors. God blesses the humble and lowly, those who recognize the need for God's grace in their life. As we prepare for Easter, let us ready our hearts in humble recognition of our need to be saved.
