

Communion Reflection... The religious leaders knew well the prophecies of the Messiah. They should have realized that they fit Jesus to a T. But they dismissed that notion as foolishness. Three times Jesus told his disciples that he must suffer and die and rise again. And yet on Easter morning, they dismissed the testimony of the faith-filled women as nonsense. On Easter afternoon, the Emmaus disciples were clueless as to who was walking beside them. These days, even some people who consider themselves to be followers of Jesus dismiss the heart of the cross' message about sin and salvation as being merely symbolic or even foolishness. However, the cross of Christ reveals to us the heart of God's love and power and wisdom. It doesn't just show us the way. The message of the cross is the way to glory everlasting, by faith in the One who turned away the wrath of God against our sin, so that we might live with him forever.



I'm not all that steady on my feet these days. I know I'm getting old. I find that often I have to LENT grab hold of things to keep my balance. I used to go walking until I discovered the ruts along the walkway seemed to be reaching out to trip me up.

Or maybe the ruts are less to blame than my own unwillingness to admit I need help. I also lean on Jesus more as my physical limitations have reminded me how much I need my Saviour. My legs may not be as strong as they once were, but even with that, I still have Jesus. He's always there to catch me with his grace and forgiveness.


