Communion Reflection... During Lent we set aside spiritual pretense. We start with ashes on our forehead to mark us "needy." We need a Saviour. We need forgiveness. We need mercy. We need grace. We need a right-hand God. And we have one! The right hand, or arm, was a biblical symbol of strength. Moses and Miriam sang, "Your right hand, O Lord, glorious in power–your right hand, O Lord, shattered the enemy." Even now, Jesus sits at the right hand of the Father in glory. God stands at our right hand! He is our strength! Lent shows us our neediness. Jesus journeying to Jerusalem is God on our right. Jesus betrayed; Jesus on trial; Jesus crucified; Jesus dead in the tomb. All of it is God at our right hand. I know there is one more big example, but it is still Lent! God is your strength.




We use that one word love to mean such different things: "I love sunsets." "I love pizza." "I love my kids to the moon." Or simply "I love you." Much of the love people express tends to

At the end of the day, there's no truer adage than "can't live with 'em, can't live without 'em." Just as our bodies need food and air, our souls need connections with other people. We are at our best when we are in healthy relationships and at our worst when

we're not. Without connections, we just are not fully human. After thirty minutes of listening to a husband and wife talk about their marriage, the therapist got up and gave the wife a big hug. "Your wife needs this every day," she said. The husband replied, "okay, but I can only bring her here on Mondays and Thursdays." I know people who live with regrets after taking another person for granted and missing the opportunities to express and demonstrate affection. Saying "I love you" and following the words with hugs and kissed strengthens a relationship. Otherwise, it will die a slow death. Lost moments are lost moments, and there's no going back. During Lent, ask yourself: "Have I been taking someone for granted?" Do something about it–a visit, a phone call, a text, a hug, a kiss...connect with them through words and actions.

What Should I do for Lent?

Keep it Simple... Prayer is a recognition that we need help to turn back to God. From daily Mass, to the Rosary, to



Centering Prayer, to the Stations of the Cross, to Eucharistic Adoration, the Church encourages a wealth of prayerful practices. A very simple way to pray is to sit quietly for a moment before taking up one of the Gospels and slowly reading a passage that you like. Simply sit with the passage for a bit, savouring the Word and allowing it to touch you, read it again slowly, and then respond to God.


