### Communion Reflection... Christianity is a

meaningful way of life. As Christians, we do not only understand that all is a gift, we must acknowledge the particular gifts with which we are entrusted. This is not always easy, not because the gifts are not present, but because many of us have been taught a false sense of humility that downplays any giftedness or special contribution we might make to the world. When you name the talents and skills you have, for example, you are much more able to offer them in service, sharing, and caring. You may explore the ways your talents equip you to show God's love in special ways. You might recognize a particular ministry that needs your time, attention, and presence in the way that only you can offer. By acknowledging that you have particular gifts that are entrusted to you, you may more intentionally make those gifts fruitful. In doing so, you point to God, who is the giver of all good gifts, and give glory to God through your faith.


