**Communion Reflection...** Your parents asked you to care for their garden while they were away. Out of love and a deep sense of responsibility, you went to the garden every afternoon on your way home from work. Imagine being able to greet your parents on their return with the first fruits of the harvest, or to show them how you added a special fertilizer to the vegetables, which are now flourishing. One of the most familiar of Jesus' parable is the one involving servants who are entrusted with sums of their master's money. Two of the servants invest the money and present him with the profit on his return. The third, however, buries the money. On the master's return, the third gives back the one coin. The first two are called "good and faithful" servants, while the third is declared "wicked and lazy." You are responsible and will be held accountable for the many gifts that have been entrusted to you. Like being the one who cares for your parents' garden responsibly, you may hope to one day hear God say, "Well done, good and faithful servant!"

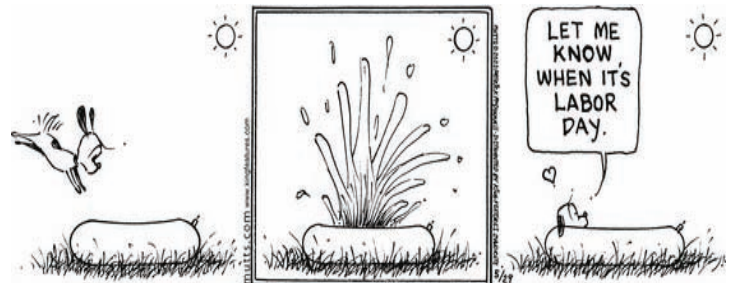


If you travel, you've learned that the best way to know a place is to walk it. Big cities, small towns, country lanes—if you don't walk them, you can't know them. It's the view from when you are on your feet that pops things into 3D. It should not surprise us then that when God came to us, he decided to walk. Jesus was no sedan chair tour guide dispensing wisdom from afar to the unwashed masses. No, Jesus walked right up to people; he walked right up to us! The disciples could hardly keep up. But only Jesus knows the route. It was more like a circuit through representatives of all humanity. He wanted to get to know us on a deep and individual level. No matter where we were, he walked to us. Nothing could slow him down. One time, he walked into a crowded room so he could speak God's forgiveness into a man's heart just before he spoke life into his dead legs. "Throw that mat away and start walking," he said to the man, which the man immediately did. Like that man, we are beckoned to put one foot in front of the other down the path Christ has mapped out for us.

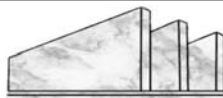
