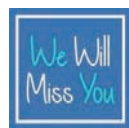


From the Pastors Desk

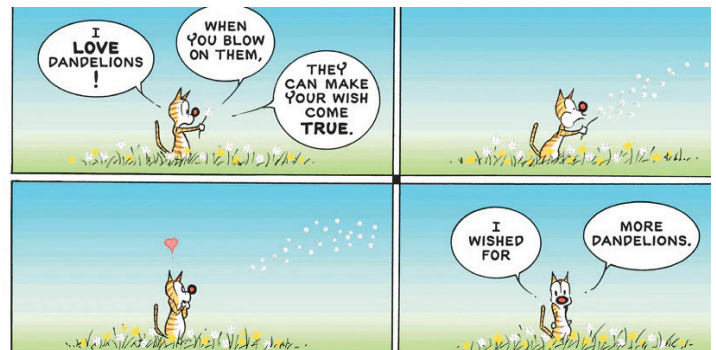
Provide A Meal... This weekend is our Chili

There are some things angels can't

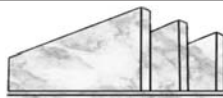
