Communion Reflection...

Aristotle stated, "Time is the most unknown of all unknown things." It is a mystery we can't escape. I remember being a younger person, and time seemed to drag. How that changes as we age! Now it seems to take off without us. My dad measured time with a Thursday ritual. After supper, he'd roll the garbage cans to the front curb for waste pickup. Without fail, he'd ask no one in particular, "Where did the week go?" Back then I had no idea what he was talking about, but now I do. The mystery of time was not his—or mine—to solve. He'd ask the rhetorical question and then let it go. He valued the present too much to dwell on the past or worry about the future. He chose to embrace each passing moment as a gift from God. As I get older now, I see him as he encourages me to do the same. Lord, open my heart to the wonders of this day.



When our hearts are filled with gratitude, we see ourselves and the world differently. We grow in understanding that we do more than simply care for or protect the gifts we have been

given. We nurture the gifts and make them fruitful. Life changes when we realize we have been entrusted with much. Our lives are not meant to be frittered away in idle activity, like gifts that remain in an unopened box. This is not to say that you should not have leisure time. In fact, keeping Sabbath is essential. You need time to focus on God, to rest, and to be renewed in mind, body, and spirit. Sabbath is very much tied to the process of growing, because in Sabbath you will more readily recognize who you are called to be and what you are called to do. What gifts have been entrusted to you? How will you use them?

We live in an age of memoirs. Our stories, however enthralling we think them to be, are short stories. Our storylines change from person to person, but they're really exactly the same. Just three chapters: we are born, we live our 4 score and 10 plus years, and then we die. That's our storyline. We need a larger story, a more interesting story, one with more than three chapters. Reading through the Gospels, we notice Jesus' attitude about this life. He doesn't seem to think that death of the body is the end of our story, though at times we're tempted to adopt that view and the fear it generates. Jesus has a larger story in mind for us—His. The thing is, he weaves us into His story, and we become a part of it. His story, far more interesting and surpassingly longer than our own, becomes ours. Jesus, thank you for weaving me into your eternal story.

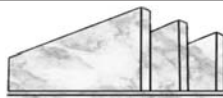
