**Communion Reflection...** On January 30, 1986, millions of school children watched the memorial service for Christa McAuliffe, the teacher and astronaut who died in the Challenger Space Shuttle disaster. The most comfort and hope that the cleric offered to the grieving was to say that she would live on in our memories. St. Paul, however, offers genuine and lasting comfort and hope. Jesus does not merely live on in our memories. Paul assures us that Jesus was truly raised from the dead, victorious over the power of death and the grave, our hope in Christ is real. God is alive! Our Easter faith gives us a lifelong mission—to proclaim to all people that death does not have the last word. Because Jesus lives, we can confidently face every day with the promise of eternity as our true hope.



Those who know us best are in the best position to betray us. They know the stuff that will hurt us most. It's the

deepest cut. But betrayals aren't the worst thing; our natural responses to them are. Those who knew Jesus best were in the best possible position to betray him. One did. The betrayal caused unbelievable pain and heartache. And yet there was no bitterness, payback or anger from Jesus. No denial, cowardice, betrayal or political machination will keep Jesus from his appointed mission: to love us to the end.


