

Communion Reflection... The present hour is a curious place to inhabit. Behind us is everything we remember and choose to forget. Ahead of us is everything we hope for, or perhaps dread. The book of Deuteronomy exists in that kind of already-and-not-yet space of the present. Moses has brought the nation through forty years of community formation. He's about to leave them as they go forward across the Jordan into the land of promise, while he stays behind to meet his Maker in ultimate ways. Not a lot actually happens in Deuteronomy, Moses tells the story of yesterday and dreams about tomorrow. Standing at the crossroads, he asks the nation to remember, before they move into what the future holds. Religion is a great deal about this sort of activity: standing still, telling stories, and remembering. At the crossroads of memory and hope, we recollect who we've been and who we mean to become. The past gives us context and identity. The future gives us room to grow and change.



If you've ever baked bread from scratch, which seems to the fad now-a-days, you know the yeast (or starter) is the key ingredient in the whole enterprise. The ability to "raise up" the mixture is what makes flour and water into

bread. We all seem to be adept at dragging things down with our criticism, judgements, negativity and even complaints about the weather. Yet it's more creative and challenging to be the leaven—to find the proverbial silver lining, the divine essence or the ray of hope that raises up a situation. It takes only a small amount of leaven to get good action going. It could merely be your smile, a friendly joke or a remark like, "Hey, you look great today!" The whole lump of this life needs us to be working like yeast to build the kingdom. Today's challenge—with a kind word, raise someone up.


