Communion Reflection... What does it mean to trust? Trust implies confidence in a relationship that's reliable in every season. If we've got good news, those whom we trust celebrate it with us. When we mourn, they shed real tears. When we're out of line, they tell us so—and don't walk away. If we go broke, they provide a loan or the couch. When we're humiliated wrongly, they don't avoid us like everyone else. Trusting someone gives us somewhere to turn when there's no place else to go. Often we put our trust in the wrong place: in people who are unreliable, a steady paycheck, a piece of land, a retirement fund, or our own abilities. Hanging from this flawed branch, it can be perilous when the bough breaks. St. Mary MacKillop tells us to "Trust in God's Providence, interfering—as is alway does—for our own good."

This past year's been tough on the heart.

Sickness and death, job loss and anxiety, isolation and loneliness: we weren't spared much in the lottery of misfortune. We've all fought for home

behind our masks and inside of our six feet of sacred distance. Prophecy isn't normally the cure for the blues. Prophets do a lot of hollering: at rulers, priests, and people, telling them to wise up. Depending on the liturgical route, we've offered consolations from Jeremiah or Ezekiel. Jeremiah chapter 31 may be the happiest biblical passage this side of John the Baptist. Ezekiel chapter 37 contains the Dry Bones vision of a lifeless community fully restored. When these two guys are both optimistic, you know it's safe to hope! Make a new covenant with God. Ask for the restoration you need.


