

Communion Reflection... Some people appear to be only a small part of our daily activities. They call now and then or occasionally visit. We almost take it for granted that they will always be there. Then someone moves away or goes off to college. Suddenly we come to realize how much a part of our life they've turned out to be and we miss them. Believe it or not some people actually take God for granted. He's always there and that's that. As life goes on, a vacuum develops in our spiritual life. We feel adrift and are unable to maintain a sense of direction or control. The inner serenity we are accustomed to isn't there anymore. All that's necessary to restore that inner peace is a willingness to keep in touch with Him. No long distance calls or letters are necessary; just a short prayer will do.



PASTOR'S We all make mistakes that we'd just as soon forget **CORNER** but for some people forgetting is not so easy. Their past errors haunt them and haunt them persistently. The power of our good deeds could

be equally, if not more, persistent. God never forgets the good we have done or how sorry we are for the errors we've committed. He sees the good as being more outstanding than the bad, especially if we used the errors of our ways to learn something about being a better Christian. It's okay to think about our past mistakes, but to let them overpower our progress in drawing closer to God is to give them more power than they deserve. Jesus called sinners to "follow me" so get in line behind Him and stop clinging to the past.

So often we get caught up in the insignificant things of life and allow them to almost completely overtake us. This could happen in a relationship when we sense that someone is

being unkind or insensitive to us. We focus on the hurt we feel, and, at that moment, we act as if nothing else in the world really mattered. At these times the wider picture gets lost. To succeed in life we need to become aware of the eternal perspective. Without the bigger picture, we inevitably make the wrong decision. We don't see things clearly, and so don't act properly. As we approach the end of our Church year, we are reminded today that life as we know it will come to an end. What seems so important to us today will disappear like a puff of smoke. Perhaps we could use this time as a chance to look at those things in our lives which take up most of our energies. Are they really that important? Would it be a disaster if I spent less time and energy on some of them? Do other things in my life need more attention. In the bigger picture, what are the things or situations in my life that need more of my care?

During the month of November, we take the time to pause and remember those who have died and await the resurrection of the body at the end of time, especially



those in our parish cemeteries. "May the Lord grant eternal rest to them and send his comfort and strength to us, the living, as we look forward to our reunion, one day, in the glory of God's eternal kingdom in heaven."
