

Whenever someone is being considered for employment, the person doing the hiring studies the applicant's resume and considers their past accomplishments. This applies to

corporations as well as to someone looking for an individual to do work around their home. Usually the person who has successfully accomplished the most in the required field is hired for the job. Sometime life's challenges find us a bit apprehensive about whether we are the right person to accomplish the task that lies before us. Maybe it would help if we looked at the things we've already accomplished in life and how well we handled those challenges. It boils down to asking, "If you could read your own life's resume, would you hire yourself for the task ahead?" God has already answered the question in the affirmative. That's why you have this new challenge in the first place.

On All Souls Day, we not only remember the dead, but we apply our efforts, through prayer, almsgiving, and the Mass, to their release from Purgatory. According to our faith, the soul of a person who dies can go to one of three places. The first is heaven, where a person who dies in a state of perfect grace and communion with God goes. The second is hell, where those who die in a state of mortal sin are naturally condemned by their choice. The intermediate option is purgatory, which is thought to be where most people, free of mortal sin, but still in a state of lesser (venial) sin, must go.

Prayer for the Souls in Purgatory

O gentle Heart of Jesus, ever present in the Blessed Sacrament, ever consumed with burning love for the poor captive souls in Purgatory, have mercy on them. Be not severe in Your judgments, but let some drops of Your Precious Blood fall upon the devouring flames. And, Merciful Saviour, send Your angels to conduct them to a place of refreshment, light, and peace. Amen.

During the month of November, we take the time to pause and remember those who have died and await the resurrection of the body at the end of time, especially those in our parish cemeteries. "May the Lord grant eternal rest to them and send his comfort and strength to us, the living, as we look forward to our reunion, one day, in the glory of God's eternal kingdom in heaven."


