Communion Reflection... "I don't get it. I don't understand." I don't know how often I've said those words over my lifetime: "I'll never figure out these directions." That's when someone will say, "Why not call the handyman?" And when he comes, his first words are, "Who put this together?" And my inability to comprehend, to understand, to grasp the meaning of things goes even deeper when it comes to the love of God that surpasses any and all of my knowledge. But you know something? That doesn't bother me anymore. While I'll never understand how God could love a broken person such as myself, I know that he does. He loves me up, down, sideways, inside and out. I know because of Jesus. And as long as I live, I will strive to love him just the same.



God is not one given to speaking in the **PASTOR** abstract. Take the word love, for example. When we hear the word love, we often think

in terms of feelings and emotion, as in, "I love him or her." Or maybe how one person acts toward another: "She treats him with love and kindness." When God speaks of love, he leaves nothing to the imagination: "God is love." Now for those with faith in Christ, when Jesus speaks of truth, we know what he means: "Jesus is truth!" Those who hear his voice are all made part of that truth as we become one with him in faith. And that's the truth. Dear Jesus, you have made it clear that to know you is to know the truth, the truth that makes us free.


