

Communion Reflection... "I can't accept something so valuable," he said. "I could never pay you back." "But I want you to have it," she replied. What an extraordinary, extravagant gift! It is a gift that cannot be given apart from Christ. For God alone can forgive sins. Only Jesus Christ, true God and true man, could redeem us from

our slavery to sin by the shedding of his blood, which he poured out for us and all humanity on the cross. Having been washed in forgiveness through our baptism into Christ, our Lord sends us forth each day into our love-starved world. He empowers us to share his lavish love and forgiveness, not only with our friends and fellow believers, but even with those who have been hurtful or hateful to us. That can be as hard as nails. Lord, enable us by your grace to forgive others as lavishly as you have forgiven us.
