Communion Reflection... I must be filled with joy if my feet are on the right road and my face set towards the gate which is called beautiful, though I may fall many times in the mire and often in the mist go astray. Far off, like a perfect pearl, one can see the City of God. It is so wonderful that it seems as if a child could reach it in a summer's day. And so a child could. But with me and such as me it is different. One can realise a thing in a single moment, but one loses it in the long hours that follow the leaden feet. We think in terms of eternity, but we move slowly through time.



Sometimes our burdens may seem to be more than we can bear, especially when they are exacerbated by someone who makes our life almost unbearable. When we are overwhelmed by our own burdens and cares, how can we be expected to bear the burdens of other? God doesn't ask any more of us than he himself has experienced. In the person of his Son, he carried the weight of all of humanity's failings and burdens to the cross, where his heart was broken for us, so that we might be set free from the crushing burden of our countless offenses. There at the foot of the cross, our Lord invites us to lay our guilt and burdens down—and leave them there. Having been freed from the penalty of our sin, our load is light and enough that we can lighten the burdens of others, by sharing the weight of their heavy load. Even more important, we can invite them to join us at the foot of the cross, where Christ will become our mutual burden-bearer.



The very first Life Chain was held in 1987 in Yuba City, California and consisted of 2,500 people. The annual event grew by leaps and bounds in the following years, with Canada holding its first Life Chain in 1990, and almost 1,000,000 participating across North America in 1992. 
