

**Communion Reflection...** "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled." (Matthew 5:6) Jesus speaks these words in the Sermon on the Mount. He speaks to a world starving for hope and thirsting for something and someone to believe in. What's more, Jesus doesn't just speak words of hope, he is hope. He doesn't just speak of the longing we have for righteousness, justice and fairness, he is justice and fairness. In short, he comes to all who have given up trying to make sense of this life and have resigned themselves to living in despair.



I remember one day when a congregation at a church I was visiting was singing "Take my life and let it be consecrated, Lord, to thee..." They sang with a gusto that rocked the walls. But it was more than that. It was the beginning

of a greater understanding on the part that God doesn't just want to be part of my reality, my life, he wants to be my reality, my life. He wants all of me ... heart, soul, mind and strength. And why not? Isn't that what Jesus gave to me? Someone once said that he rejoiced that Jesus was alive, but he also prayed that Jesus would come alive in him. Do you want that too? Dear Lord, help me to hear the music of your faithfulness. As you have given your all for me, help me give my all for you. Please pray for peace and especially the people of Ukraine; join us in saying a Hail Mary every day.


