Heavenly Creator,


In this season of gratitude and abundance,

Communion Reflection... My friend is a public defender. Her work has opened up for me the world of the accused and the incarcerated, and the knotty questions surrounding these realities. One organization she has worked with is devoted to helping prisoners who have clearly reformed but remain incarcerated, sometimes because of technicalities or laws that aren't even enforced anymore. As she shares the group's success stories, I'm always struck by the absence of bitterness or resentment in the stories of the inmates. Having spent much time often unjustly confined, these people find reason to be grateful, even while still behind prison walls. Often that reason is spiritual. It humbles me every time. We all live with limitations. As time passes, it's inevitable we'll be living with more and more of them. But with Jesus: No matter where I am—I remain "free indeed."



To live in the world without being controlled and consumed by the distorted standards and values of this world is like walking a tightrope. Tightrope walkers tell us that they keep their eyes focused on a certain spot on the other side. They dare not get distracted by anything along the way. Likewise, on our journey across the tightrope of life, we dare not allow ourselves to get distracted by the so-called "good things in life," which the world promises will bring us happiness and fulfilment. Sadly, many people discover too late that the rewards this world offers lead eventually to a dead end. With God's help we are able to keep our heart and mind focused on the prize on the other side, Heaven.

The most famous verse in the Bible is probably John 3:16. This verse isn't a command to "get out there and do something!" And it wasn't said to make us feel better about ourselves.

John 3:16 is a statement that answers the age old question "What must I do to get God to love me?" The answer is: He already does. But then our follow-up question is: "Yes, but can I be sure?" The answer there is a question itself: "Why else did the Lord of Life allow his own life to drain away if not for love of you?" There's more. John 3:16 causes a response. We hardly notice it at first. Things begin to die in us, while other things grow. Chronic doubting fades; trust grows. Malice dies; goodwill for others grows. What I want begins to die; what my neighbour needs begins to grow. And on it goes until we behold the Lover face to face.


