Communion Reflection... To whom will you speak today? Will your words be positive and encouraging? Will they be uplifting? The first words my parents spoke upon rising into the day were "Good morning, honey. How did you sleep?" (As they aged, an unbroken night of sleep became rare!) All day long we have ample opportunity to use our speech to thank a neighbour for shoveling our walk, to comment on the pretty name of the cashier at the grocery store, to applaud your child for their good parenting and to praise God for giving us yet another chance to be his mouthpiece. Spend a day noticing the words you say to others. How might you fine-tune them to God's glory? Thank you, Lord, for the gift of speech. May I train my tongue well to raise others up and to speak of your kingdom.

Today pollution has become a big issue, and rightly so. People want clean water, clean air, and clean food. But we should be even more concerned about the most dangerous pollution of all, namely, evil. Pride, anger, hate, lust, greed, envy... all these are dangerous pollutants. So what must we do? We must purify the source; the heart is the source. It is the well-spring from which all our thoughts, words, and deeds flow. If the heart is clean, all that flows from it will be clean. Blessed are the clean of heart; they shall see God.
