Communion Reflection... During Sunday Mass, a child couldn't resist the urge to stand up on the seat and look around. His mother kept murmuring, "Sweetheart, sit down." He'd sit for a few seconds, then hop back up. "I said, sit down!" the mother reprimanded softly. After several recurrences, he stood up and refused to sit down. His mother put her hand on his head and gently, but firmly, pushed him into the seat. The boy sat there smiling. Finally, he turned to his mother and said, "I may be sitting down on the outside, but I'm standing up on the inside." Life can change in an instant. Maybe you're facing a serious setback—bad news from the doctor, a broken relationship, the loss of a loved one, or some other crisis. Whenever heartaches and problems arise, our real inner strength is called upon. Even if our circumstances temporarily knock us down, we must envision ourselves standing up on the inside, filled with resilience and tenacity. Jesus urges us to walk forward and experience the next opportunity waiting for us. When the dust settles, we'll be standing strong because we can hear Jesus say, "Stand up, take my hand, and move forward, one step at a time."



Imagine if you didn't know the alphabet or basic math facts. How hard would it be to work every word or problem out from the beginning, every time. Even our bodies have memories, don't they? If you play an instrument or sport, you know with practice your fingers and legs learn what to do. We don't ever start from scratch with God. He dwells with us, he's speaking to us. But we are learning how to listen and grow with him. We can get into the good habit of praying, our hearts don't always have to search for the words - they're already there.
