Communion Reflection... It's said that when we wish to communicate, we use words. When God wants to communicate, he takes his words and hangs flesh and blood on it. And what is that Word? It is Jesus. In the Incarnation, God's living Son takes human form, not just to tell us of God's love but to reveal God's love. And that's just the beginning. We would think that the Incarnation would be revealed in holy fanfare. That the Christ would come in power, not poverty; in a crown, not a cross; in glory not in the dust of a manger. No crown. No glory. God's unconditional love is revealed in the cross of Christ, so that in that cross, we might discover the gift of life and love that keeps on giving through you and me.



"New birth." "Living hope." Those are the words that bring new meaning to life... when we find that life in Jesus. I've heard it said: "If Jesus isn't real,

nothing matters; if Jesus is real, nothing else matters." St. Paul put it this way: "For me to live is Christ..." Jesus didn't just die, rise up again and leave us behind. Jesus died, rose again and came back to life for us. He came to breathe his life into us, to give us a new birth and living hope that no one could ever take away. Dear Heavenly Father, now when I hear the "happy birthday" song sung may it forever remind me of the day I was given new life in your Son.
